

If you are experiencing the stream starting up and dropping out every few minutes, then you are listening via a network in your office that is congested or has outdated firewalls or hardware. The audio will drop if you are unable to get consistently a 120kbps data stream into your computer. Many older firewalls that use proxy technology do not work with our stream. Try listening via the alternative methods listed below.

If you only hear the introductory commercial to the stream, then nothing – then you are certainly being blocked by streaming by your company’s firewall. If your company is using a proxy system, you are being blocked simply because proxy access systems do not work with the latest streaming protocols being used on the internet. Try listening via the alternative methods listed below.

Alternative Methods:

You can listen to our stations via your iTunes software. Version 9 of iTunes is required to play our AAC (highest audio quality) streams. Older versions of iTunes (8 and older) can playback our MP3 streams.

If you have your own player such as iTunes, Windows Media Player, Winamp or a device such as a Roku Soundbridge, you can load our streams using the manual links to the streams listed below:

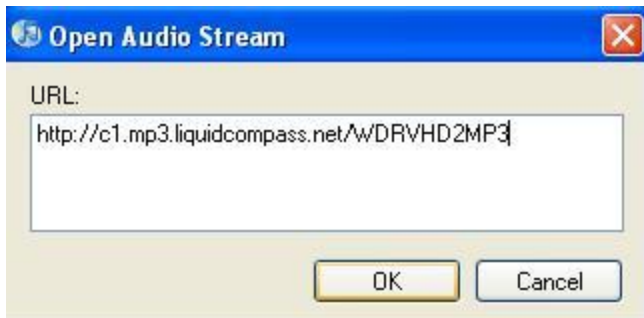
